Fetal and neonatal care equipment enhances health outcomes for these premature infants by enabling healthcare professionals to monitor vital signs effectively, provide necessary treatments, and maintain safety in intensive care settings. For example, in January 2025, the Government's response to the House of Lords inquiry on preterm births in the UK reported that 8.1% of all births in 2023 were preterm, occurring between 24 and 36 completed weeks of gestation. This growing incidence of premature births is expected to continue driving demand for specialized fetal and neonatal care devices.
