Published by Spines, this deeply personal collection of poems navigates the trials of life, family, and spiritual awakening.

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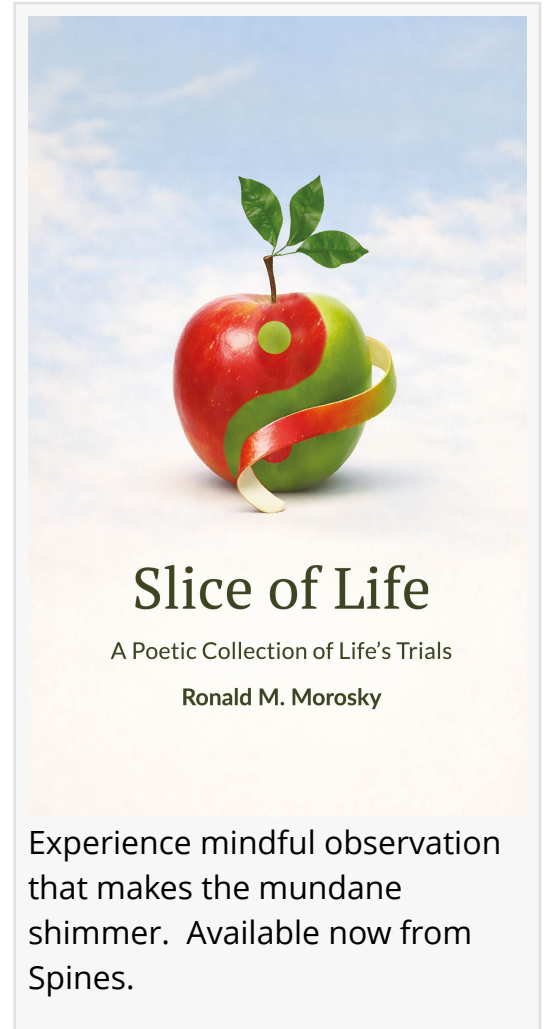
