Denver contractor details the background screening and site access requirements behind commercial painting work in Colorado secure facilities

Secure-facility contracting refers to construction and maintenance work performed inside buildings where access is restricted for security reasons, requiring contractors to complete identity verification and background screening, follow escorted or restricted access rules, and coordinate schedules directly with facility security personnel before any work begins.

Those requirements are becoming more common across Colorado. The state ranks first in the nation per capita for aerospace employment, with more than 2,000 aerospace businesses employing over 55,000 people directly, according to the Colorado Office of Economic Development and International Trade. Colorado also hosts half of the nation's Space Force presence, along with the U.S. Northern Command, the North American Aerospace

Defense Command, and three of the six U.S. Space Force bases. As that footprint grows, so does

demand for contractors who can perform routine building maintenance and renovation work inside restricted environments.

For contractors, technical skill is only part of the qualification. Projects inside secure facilities routinely require background checks, identity verification, restricted site access, and coordination with facility managers and security staff before work is authorized. Personnel lists, equipment, materials, and daily schedules are typically approved in advance, and changes mid-project can require re-approval.

"Projects like these remind you that professionalism begins long before the first day on site," said Spencer Melfi, owner of Harmony Painting. "Preparation, communication, and respect for established security protocols are every bit as important as the craftsmanship itself."

Harmony Painting maintains team member screening documentation and uses in-house crews rather than subcontractors, which simplifies the personnel approval process that secure sites require. The company performs [commercial painting work](#) for offices, retail centers, [warehouses and industrial facilities](#), multifamily communities, and homeowner associations across the Denver metro area and the Front Range, and it schedules many projects during evenings and weekends to avoid disrupting operations.

As Colorado continues expanding its presence in aerospace, advanced manufacturing, and defense technology, security-conscious construction practices are becoming a standard part of commercial contracting in the region. Completing work inside highly regulated environments reflects both technical capability and the administrative discipline these facilities require.
