

Champion FleetCare Joins Enterprise Fleet Management Network to Serve More Kansas City Fleets

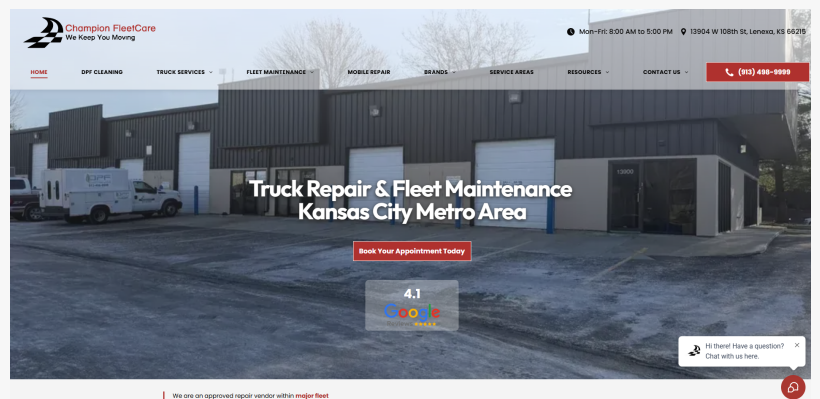
Champion FleetCare joined the Enterprise Fleet Management network, giving Kansas City fleets direct access to its shop and mobile truck repair services.

The approval allows companies that manage their vehicles through Enterprise Fleet Management to send repairs and scheduled service directly to Champion FleetCare's Lenexa facility. Service can also be sent to its mobile service teams. For fleet operators, that removes a vendor-onboarding step and shortens the path to getting high-utilization vehicles back on the road.

Since opening in 2020, Champion FleetCare has built its reputation on work that many general shops send elsewhere. This includes diesel troubleshooting, DPF cleaning, and complex emissions repair, as well as everyday maintenance. Its team serves commercial fleets, diesel and



gas trucks, trailers, vans, buses, RVs, and motorhomes. Service is available throughout Lenexa, Olathe, Overland Park, Shawnee, De Soto, and the surrounding Kansas City metro area. For fleet managers, the Enterprise approval ultimately comes down to uptime. [Fleet Maintenance in Lenexa, KS](#) includes preventive maintenance programs, DOT inspections, diesel and gas truck repair, DPF cleaning, and electrical and emissions diagnostics. Routing that work through the Enterprise network streamlines authorization and billing, so approved vehicles move from diagnosis to repair to back in service with fewer administrative delays. The milestone follows a period of growth for the company, which recently expanded into a larger 15,000-square-foot facility to add capacity for commercial fleets. Champion FleetCare also works with other fleet platforms, including Fleetio and Wheels, and offers corporate billing and fleet credit options for approved customers.

Because demand for diesel and emissions service tends to spike during extreme summer heat and winter cold, the added capacity helps fleets stay ahead of seasonal breakdowns. It allows fleets to prepare for service needs rather than scramble after problems occur.
