Cleveroad ranks third among the top 10 web developers for financial services in the United States in Clutch's Q3 2026 ranking, based on verified client reviews.

The ranking is built from evidence rather than submissions. Clutch evaluates service providers through verified client interviews, project and experience data, and measured market presence, and ratings for the directory were last updated on Aug. 6, 2026. Cleveroad

Founded in 2011, with offices in the United States and Estonia, Cleveroad is listed in the directory

from New York and holds 80+ reviews on Clutch, average rating 4.9/5. Web development and custom software development lead its service mix, followed by mobile app development, AI agents, AI development, and API development. Its [fintech software development services](#) sit alongside work in healthcare, logistics, insurance, retail, education, and eCommerce.

Suffescom Solutions Inc

A New York full-stack web development company rated 4.9 from 120 reviews, the largest review count in the top 10. Its practice spans web development, mobile app development, and blockchain. The firm builds custom websites and web applications for financial services clients.

Wakefly, Inc.

A Westborough, Massachusetts firm rated 4.8 from 24 reviews. Web development leads its practice, followed by custom software development, with pay-per-click advertising and UX/UI design alongside. The mix pairs engineering work with demand generation for its clients.

FocusReactive

A New York firm rated 4.9 from 25 reviews, one of four New York-based firms in the top 10. Its practice centers on web development and custom software development. The company works in full-stack builds and custom website solutions.

Topflight Apps

An Irvine, California firm rated 4.9 from 43 reviews. Mobile app development leads its practice, alongside web development, AI development, UX/UI design, and wearable app development. Low-code and no-code delivery rounds out six listed service categories.

Marcel Digital

A Chicago-based digital agency rated 4.8 from 20 reviews, the only Illinois firm in the top 10. It combines web development with search engine optimization and digital strategy. Search visibility work sits alongside its build and engineering services.

Simpalm

A Rockville, Maryland firm rated 4.9 from 64 reviews, the third-highest review count in the top 10. Mobile app development and web development lead its practice, with web design and application management and support alongside. Its portfolio includes progressive web app work.

Urban Insight

A Los Angeles firm rated 5.0 from 37 reviews, one of two perfect ratings in the top 10. Web development accounts for most of its practice, followed by web design and UX/UI design. Most of its capacity sits on build and interface work.

thoughtbot

A New York firm rated 4.9 from 39 reviews. Web development leads its practice, followed by

mobile app development, UX/UI design, cloud consulting, and custom software development. Ruby on Rails features prominently in the firm's engineering work.

Oomph, Inc.

A Providence, Rhode Island firm rated 5.0 from 18 reviews, the smallest review count in the top 10. Web development leads its practice, with digital strategy, UX/UI design, web design, and AI development listed alongside it.

Cleveroad's own position in this market rests on regulated, data-heavy work, where audit and compliance pressure shapes the build as much as the requirements do. Projects run under an ISO 9001 and ISO/IEC 27001 certified process, with SOC 2 and AWS Select Tier Partner status, and a compliance history covering PCI DSS, GDPR, and HIPAA. Engagements range from custom software development to dedicated teams and IT staff augmentation, for clients across North America, Western Europe, and the Middle East.

"Financial services buyers screen development partners on evidence rather than positioning, and a directory of this size makes that screening harder," said Ivan Stepankov, head of growth and partnerships at Cleveroad. "Every input behind this placement came from clients Clutch interviewed about systems we built and shipped."

The placement continues a pattern rather than standing alone. Cleveroad earned Clutch Champion recognition in Spring 2025 and again in Fall 2025, along with a place on the Clutch Top 1000 list for 2025 and Clutch Global status. Outside the platform, the company has been named to the Inc. 5000, recognized by the Webby Awards, and included in the Forbes Technology Council.
