Shifts in lifestyles and eating habits are expected to play a significant role in driving demand for hair supplements in the coming years. Urbanization has transformed daily routines, leading to busier schedules and a preference for convenient, processed foods rather than traditional home-cooked meals. Such lifestyle changes impact overall health and increase consumers' interest in supplements that promote beauty and wellness from within.

Growing health consciousness and improved dietary choices also contribute to the market's expansion by boosting awareness of nutrition's importance for hair care. For example, in April 2023, the International Food Information Council, a US-based nonprofit, reported survey results from 1,022 Americans aged 18 to 80, revealing that 52% followed a specific diet in the past year. Younger generations led this trend, with 66% of Gen Z and 63% of Millennials adhering to diets, compared to 50% of Gen X and 41% of Boomers (an increase from 29% in 2022). Popular diets included high-protein (18%), mindful eating (17%), calorie counting, clean eating, and intermittent fasting (each at 12%). These evolving dietary habits are expected to fuel further growth in the hair supplements market.
