Benchmark Study Highlights Industry-Wide Shifts

The 2026 Global Compliance Benchmark Study points to a broader move toward connected compliance ecosystems that unify employee conduct oversight, information barriers, AI governance, workflow management, and evidence generation. Key findings include:

- Artificial Intelligence Adoption: Compliance organizations are moving from AI experimentation toward operational deployment across surveillance and oversight functions.
- Digital Assets and Prediction Markets: New asset classes are introducing insider trading risk, policy gaps, and surveillance requirements that existing compliance frameworks do not fully address.
- Information Barriers: Firms face growing pressure to modernize control room operations as data moves more freely across business functions and jurisdictions.
- Connected Compliance Ecosystems: Organizations are consolidating employee conduct oversight, AI governance, and evidence generation into unified compliance programs.
