

# TicketSys.org Launches Prelaunch Waitlist for New Self-Service Event Ticketing and Check-In Platform

*Businesses, organizations, and groups can now join the waitlist for TicketSys, a self-service ticketing and check-in platform launching in September.*

VANCOUVER, BRITISH COLUMBIA, CANADA, August 7, 2026 /EINPresswire.com/ -- Arneen Media today announced the prelaunch of [TicketSys.org](https://ticketsys.org), a self-service event ticketing and check-in platform built for businesses, organizations, and community groups that want to run their own events without giving up their ticket revenue to a third-party platform. TicketSys is expected to launch in early September 2026, and prelaunch waitlist signups are open now at <https://ticketsys.org>.

TicketSys is built on [Biz Boom Box](#), Arneen Media's CRM automation system on the GoHighLevel platform, and is designed to let organizers keep the entire ticketing process in-house: selling tickets or collecting RSVPs, checking in guests by QR code scan from any phone, sending attendee mailings and reminders, and tracking live sales and attendance data, all from one place, with every signup syncing automatically into the organizer's own CRM.

"Organizations shouldn't have to hand over a cut of every ticket they sell just to run a clean check-in line," said a spokesperson for Arneen Media. "TicketSys puts that control back where it belongs, with the people running the event."

More details about the platform: TicketSys supports ticketed, RSVP, and virtual events, and can be embedded directly into an existing website or funnel with a single snippet. Once an organizer sets up an event, they can designate Assigned Ticket Admins, staff or volunteers authorized to

check in attendees on-site by scanning tickets directly from their own iOS or Android device, with no additional scanning hardware required. The platform also sends automatic confirmation, reminder, and organizer alert messages so attendees don't fall through the cracks, and gives organizers live analytics on sales, attendance, and no-shows in real time, with export available at any point.

TicketSys is built to scale from a single small gathering up to large-scale events. Organizers can set multiple ticket tiers per event, such as general admission, VIP, or group rates, and apply coupon codes for discounts or complimentary access.

Each ticket type can carry its own capacity cap, with live sold and checked-in counts visible to organizers in real time, and a "check-in all" option to process an entire group order in one tap at the door. Event pages are customizable with editable sections, colors, and branding, and support multi-day agendas for events that run sessions or stages across more than one day.



That range of tools is built to cover more than a single one-off event. TicketSys is designed to work for large conferences with 500 or more attendees that need fast, organized check-in lines and real-time capacity tracking; for gyms, studios, and fitness businesses running recurring classes, memberships, and multi-session programs that need repeatable, easy-to-duplicate event setups; and for organizations hosting online or virtual events that still need clean registration, reminders, and attendee tracking without the in-person check-in component.

Prelaunch access is priced under \$200 per month, with no long-term contracts, unlimited events, and early-access pricing for organizations that join the waitlist ahead of the September launch.

"The 'Why' behind TicketSys is to solve seeing the same problem across our own clients: great events, but no ownership over the ticketing data or the profits," Derek added. "This gives any business or group the same tools the big [ticketing platforms](#) use, without the fees or the middleman."
