Areas that have to be addressed are the Farm Safety nets that account for high input costs and persistently low prices, stronger conservation funding and protections against corporate monopolies. All areas have to be looked at in the long term not the short term.

Arkansas Farmers Union is asking our lawmakers from both parties to set aside their bias and work together to get a stronger Farm Bill signed into law.

This Farm Bill might be the most important Farm Bill ever for the security of our food supply chain not just for present day farmers and consumers but for future generations to come.

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
