Businesses, nonprofits, public agencies, educational organizations, and entrepreneurs whose work aligns with these areas are encouraged to apply. The Expo offers participating organizations an opportunity to increase community visibility, connect directly with Richmond residents and leaders, and build relationships with others working across the sustainability sector.

Opening ceremonies will begin at 11 a.m. with city representatives. The event is free and open to all. The Sustainable Richmond Expo 2026 is presented by the Sustainability/Business, Industrial Hemp Subcommittee of the Richmond Economic Development Commission, with support from the Economic Development Department.
