The technical architecture of the 100 to 200 tons per day system begins with raw material storage, utilizing either durable steel silos or standard warehouse facilities. From storage, the grain enters a rigorous multi-stage cleaning phase, followed by dampening, peeling, and germ extraction, before moving into the core milling, screening, conveying, and automated packing stages.

Maintaining consistency across this entire process requires specialized equipment that works in seamless sequence. The 50 tons per day configuration demonstrates this continuous material flow by incorporating a series of precise mechanical components. The system utilizes vibration screens, destoners, and magnetic separation equipment to remove stones and metallic impurities, thereby protecting the downstream milling rollers from damage. Following the cleaning phase, dedicated degerming equipment prepares the maize for the milling machines and screening equipment, ensuring optimal extraction rates. The final product is then smoothly transferred to packing machines, completing a continuous cycle that maximizes operational stability.

Customization Links Capacity with Finished-Product and Packing Plans

Industrial grain processing cannot rely on rigid machinery configurations that ignore local market variations.
