HLF/RLF three-phase systems, and 60 to 300 kW ZWM modular systems. That distinction lets buyers discuss the full solution range first, then lock the exact model, voltage, phase, and battery configuration in project documents.

For HLF-33 and RLF-33, the published baseline includes 3 x 380 VAC three-phase-plus-neutral input and output, a 285 to 475 VAC input range, plus or minus 1 percent output accuracy, and voltage customization.

Industrial UPS Range and Customization Support Project Fit



Project fit depends on choosing the correct UPS architecture as well as capacity. High-frequency transformer-less units support compact online power protection, transformer-based low-frequency systems address larger critical loads, modular UPS supports scalable power blocks, and outdoor IP55 models cover pole- or wall-mounted use. Each series carries its own input range, phase structure, output accuracy, and installation limits.

Voltage and battery configuration tie destination grid conditions, equipment interfaces, backup-time targets, and project capacity together. The campaign material highlights custom solutions and long backup time, while the official listings confirm that multiple series can be customized for input and output voltage. The final runtime and battery-bank design should therefore be fixed through the quotation, model documentation, and load profile rather than assumed from a headline capacity.

Full-Chain Technical Support Starts Before Production
