

Rapper SanMinor Promotes 'Dystopian Rap' to Explore Digital Control and Society

Independent artist SanMinor fuses underground hip-hop with classic dystopian literature to critique digital surveillance, algorithms, and tech control.

LOS ANGELES, CA, UNITED STATES, August 10, 2026 /EINPresswire.com/ -- As automated systems and modern technologies increasingly reshape our daily lives, independent producer and rapper Alexander Didenko (performing under the alias [SanMinor](#)) has emerged as a representative of a unique musical subgenre that blends dark [underground hip-hop](#) with the philosophy of classic science fiction.

SanMinor - the conceptual project of songwriter, beatmaker, and producer Alexander Didenko - is expanding his exploration of what he calls "[Dystopian Rap](#)". This is a distinctive subgenre designed to challenge the superficial, purely commercial formulas that dominate contemporary pop culture.

Drawing on the literary traditions of works such as George Orwell's 1984 and Aldous Huxley's Brave New World, the

project consciously moves away from the street tales or personal dramas typical of the subgenre. Instead, the creative focus shifts to the psychological pressures of the digital age and the growing influence of algorithms on human life.

"While modern discussions about technology often focus on whether automated tools can

create hit songs, I am most concerned with the human aspect: how will people change when invisible algorithms begin to dictate their emotions and decisions?" reflects Alexander Didenko (SanMinor). "For me, 'Dystopian Rap' isn't a rigid academic classification, but an organic space where hip-hop intersects with the profound philosophical questions characteristic of classic dystopian literature."

The SanMinor story began in 2014 with a project focused on lyrical hip-hop. A significant thematic shift occurred in 2021 with the release of the single "1984", which officially steered the project toward science fiction and dystopian themes. This creative direction was solidified by subsequent major releases, including the "Isolation" ("Изоляция") EP and the 2024 project "Brave New World" ("Дивный новый мир").

The project's discography features powerful tracks such as "QR Code", "To Be Human", and "Anti World". In each of these, the dense sound of analog synthesizers and heavy underground beats create a dark, atmospheric environment that reflects the complexities of life in a technology-dominated society. With plans for further international expansion, SanMinor continues to build a community of listeners who value deep conceptual storytelling and uncompromising independent music.
