The Winter Forest Dragon is a seven-foot creature with flapping wings, glowing blue eyes, a turning head, and an optional fog-machine connection. The Mother Life-Size Professional Halloween Animatronic, a made-to-order rocking-chair scene that lunges forward with an axe when triggered.

Additional oversized clowns, reapers, witches, skeletons, and animated graveyard pieces are designed to serve as focal points in larger Halloween scenes.

Several figures include combinations of motion, sound, lighting, and sensor activation. The assortment gives buyers options for porch displays, indoor walkthroughs, cemetery scenes, commercial attractions, and full haunted-house installations.
