What started as a small Sydney firm now serves clients across New South Wales, Victoria, Queensland, South Australia, and the Australian Capital Territory, offering a digital-first alternative in an industry many people find complex and intimidating.

"To be recognised as a finalist two years running tells us we're building something that resonates," said Daniella Muzitano, Founder and Executive Director of Titlespace. "When I started Titlespace in 2019, the goal was simple: make conveyancing something people could actually understand and feel supported through. Since then we've grown from a single Sydney practice to serving clients across five states and territories, most recently South Australia and the ACT, and this recognition belongs to the team who show up for clients at what is, for many, the

biggest financial moment of their lives."

Titlespace operates on a digital-first, fixed-fee model, so clients know the cost of their conveyancing up front rather than facing variable hourly billing. Clients can track each step of their matter online while receiving personal support from in-house conveyancers and property lawyers, and settlements are completed electronically through PEXA, an

electronic settlement platform used for property transactions across Australia. The firm says this combination of transparent pricing, technology, and personal service is what has built its client relationships since 2019.
