

60,000 Orphans in Gaza: Life for Relief and Development (LIFE) Releases Inspiring New Song to Raise Awareness

Humanitarian Music Campaign Calls on People Worldwide to Listen, Share, and Turn Compassion into Action

SOUTHFIELD, MI, UNITED STATES, August 11, 2026 /EINPresswire.com/ -- Today, an estimated 60,000 orphans in Gaza have lost one or both parents. Many now face extreme hunger, repeated displacement, limited access to education, unsafe drinking water, and the daily uncertainty of survival. Countless children are recovering from injuries without family members by their side, while others are navigating profound grief and trauma in overcrowded displacement camps.

The crisis extends far beyond physical survival. Research consistently shows that prolonged exposure to conflict significantly increases the risk of anxiety, depression, and post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) among children.

"Compassion begins when we allow ourselves to truly see another person's reality," said Dr. Hany Saqr, CEO of Life for Relief and Development. "This song is an invitation to pause and reflect on the lives of thousands of children who deserve the same opportunities, safety, and love that we would want for any child. When awareness grows, so does the possibility for meaningful action."

For 33 years, Life for Relief and Development (LIFE) has served the people of Gaza. Since 2019, LIFE has worked to ensure that orphan sponsorship extends far beyond financial assistance. Every sponsored child receives comprehensive support designed to protect not only their

immediate survival but also their opportunity to learn, grow, and build a future.

Despite operating in one of the world's most challenging humanitarian environments, LIFE has built one of the most comprehensive orphan sponsorship programs possible inside Gaza. Through solar-powered water filtration systems, sponsored children continue to receive clean drinking water even during power outages. Fully equipped tent schools staffed by qualified teachers help preserve access to education for thousands of children despite repeated displacement. Nutritious food, healthcare, [psychosocial support](#), weather-appropriate clothing, and emergency shelter work together to provide children with stability, dignity, and the essential support every child needs to thrive.
