She also encourages women to remain authentic as they develop professionally. For Anedria, growth does not mean abandoning the qualities and values that make a person distinctive. It means learning how to use those qualities with intention, confidence, and purpose.

One of the greatest challenges in child welfare is balancing high-volume responsibilities with continuous learning, thoughtful decision-making, and the need to adapt to changing circumstances. The work requires resilience, accuracy, sound judgment, and an understanding that administrative decisions can affect children, families, employees, and entire communities.

Although the responsibility can be demanding, Anedria views challenges as opportunities to strengthen systems and improve service delivery. She brings a solutions-focused perspective to her work and remains committed to developing processes that promote accountability while recognizing the human beings behind every assignment, record, and decision.
