One current proof-of-concept initiative focuses on digitizing cryogenic inventory records using cloud-based artificial intelligence and optical character recognition technologies. The project is designed to help convert handwritten and paper-based cryostorage records into searchable digital information, potentially reducing manual data-entry requirements and helping clinics improve inventory visibility.

"Many fertility clinics have years of valuable information stored in handwritten records, spreadsheets, paper logs, and legacy systems," Butler said. "We believe AI and machine learning can help clinics unlock that information, reduce administrative work, and support more efficient and accurate operations."

The cryogenic inventory digitization initiative remains in the proof-of-concept phase. Fertility Pro is currently evaluating recognition accuracy, workflow efficiency, data-validation requirements, and the ability of the technology to process different handwriting styles and document formats.

Because the initiative remains in the proof-of-concept phase, Fertility Pro has not yet published final accuracy metrics. The company is continuing to test the technology across a range of handwritten records and cryogenic inventory formats, with human review remaining an important component of the validation process.

The company expects insights from this initiative to inform additional AI-supported capabilities across fertility practice operations, including document processing, data extraction, workflow automation, operational analytics, and clinical decision support.
