Alongside the launch, Knowledge Networks recorded dozens of podcast episodes live at the booth across its RegulatingAI and CAIO Connect shows, featuring enterprise and public-sector AI leaders from organizations including Bloomberg, Waymo, Daimler Truck North America, Uber, Digital.ai, Mars, Truist, U.S. Bank, and the New York City Council, among many others. The conversations spanned enterprise AI strategy, governance, data, and the practical realities of deploying AI at scale.



The wider Knowledge Networks ecosystem was represented throughout the event. RegulatingAI met with attendees on practical AI governance and policy. CAIO Connect convened Chief AI Officers and senior AI leaders. The NOMAI Fellowship shared the work of its founding Charter Cohort of parliamentarians, and the ERAI Fellowship connected with journalists and media leaders covering AI. The Universal AI Awards opened conversations on its 2026 editions in New Delhi and Miami, RALC introduced its CPD-accredited Responsible AI Leadership Certification ahead of launch, and the AI Speakers Bureau showcased its roster of more than 200 verified experts across 40+ countries.

With Ai4 concluded, Knowledge Networks now turns to the next milestones across its ecosystem, including the Universal AI Awards India Chapter in New Delhi and the continued roll out of the AI Policy 100. Podcast episodes recorded at the booth will be released across the Regulating AI and CAIO Connect channels in the weeks ahead.
