From 2021 to 2025, St. Louis Dermatology & Cosmetic Surgery had a compound annual growth rate of 36.0 percent. This is St. Louis Dermatology & Cosmetic Surgery's second year to achieve an Inc. 5000 ranking. The company first made the list in 2025 at the No. 1651 spot.

“Earning a place on the Inc. 5000 list for a second consecutive year reflects our team's commitment to delivering exceptional care for our patients. Sustained growth is about consistently earning our patients' trust, investing in our team, and building a practice positioned to serve this community for the long term,” said [Dr. Brandon T. Beal, MD, FAAD](#), founder of St. Louis Dermatology & Cosmetic Surgery.

The practice's growth is driven in part by its recent expansion into Chesterfield, Missouri. In July, Dr. Laura Wagner, MD joined Dr. Beal's practice, bringing Mohs surgery, non-invasive laser

rejuvenation, and full-service cosmetic dermatology to West St. Louis County patients for the first time. Over the next year, Dr. Beal and Dr. Wagner will see patients side by side as the practice transitions to St. Louis Dermatology & Cosmetic Surgery ownership.

"I grew up ten minutes from our new office, and this is home, so growing my practice in Troy and Chesterfield, MO is intentional. My father was the second and only radiologist in Troy for 35 years, and now I am the first dermatologist in that same community. I want to bring expert care close to home, because when a neighbor hears the word melanoma, the last thing they need is another hour in the car standing between them and treatment," said Dr. Beal.

Founded in 2020, St. Louis Dermatology & Cosmetic Surgery began as a single-provider office in Jacksonville, Florida. The company now operates three locations in two states, serving thousands of patients with a growing team of board-certified dermatologists, skilled physician assistants, and nurse practitioners.

This year's Inc. 5000 recognizes a new class of companies redefining what growth looks like. From AI and advanced manufacturing to healthcare, consumer products, and professional services, these businesses are expanding their impact, creating jobs, and proving that entrepreneurial ambition continues to fuel the U.S. economy. Among the 5,000 companies on the list, the median three-year revenue growth rate was 130 percent, and those companies have collectively added more than 627,208 jobs to the U.S. economy over the past three years.

Companies on the 2026 Inc. 5000 are ranked according to percentage revenue growth from 2022 to 2025. To qualify, companies must have been founded and generating revenue by March 31, 2022. They must be U.S.-based, privately held, for-profit, and independent — not subsidiaries or divisions of other companies — as of December 31, 2025. (Since then, some on the list may have gone public or been acquired.) The minimum revenue required for 2022 is \$100,000; the minimum for 2025 is \$2 million. As always, Inc. reserves the right to decline applicants for subjective reasons.
