Decades of Parasitology Research Inform the NF1 RESET Story

The connection between NF1 RESET and parasite research is deeply rooted in the work of Karim Amin’s father, Dr. Omar M. Amin, an internationally published parasitologist with over 330 articles to his credit, and founder of Parasitology Center, Inc.

Dr. Amin previously published research examining the seasonal prevalence, symptoms and host relationships associated with *Cyclospora cayetanensis* infections in North America.

In response to the current outbreak, Dr. Amin and Karim Amin have co-authored an updated paper [The Epidemiology of an Outbreak of *Cyclospora cayetanensis* in North America](#) examining the continuing public-health significance of *Cyclospora*.

“*Cyclospora* is not a new subject for our family or our research,” said Karim Amin. “Dr. Amin was studying and documenting these infections decades ago. The current outbreak makes that work especially relevant and gives us an opportunity to educate people about intestinal health, proper testing and the importance of taking these organisms seriously.”

Building a More Complete Athlete-Support System

Neuro Force One developed its platform around the belief that athletic development requires more than a collection of workouts.

The NF1 ecosystem connects training, readiness, recovery, nutrition, gut health, accountability and communication in one coordinated experience for athletes, coaches, trainers and organizations.
