The company's continued growth reflects several developments:

- Use has expanded beyond nursing into pharmacy, radiology, laboratory services, and other clinical and operational functions.

Elemeno's Shared Resource Network now includes more than 40,000 assets, giving smaller and resource-constrained healthcare organizations a practical starting point for frontline guidance, skills development, and workforce support.

- Larger health systems use Elemeno to distribute shared standards and best practices while allowing individual hospitals, departments, and units to adapt resources to their local workflows, staff, and communities.

- Elemeno is extending its role in product adoption and operational support through relationships with medical device and automation companies. Through its partnership with Swisslog Healthcare, Elemeno gives frontline staff just-in-time guidance for pharmacy automation and robotics.

The Shared Resource Network is particularly relevant to smaller and rural hospitals, which often have fewer dedicated resources for clinical education, informatics, and content development than large health systems. Elemeno enables these organizations to draw from a broad base of existing frontline resources while maintaining control over the information presented to their own teams.

The platform also addresses a growing challenge associated with health system consolidation. As independent hospitals become part of larger systems, leaders need to align policies and practices without losing the local workflows and identity that remain important to employees, physicians, and patient communities. Elemeno Health is deploying AI-assisted capabilities that help operational leaders organize, update, and deliver timely, contextually relevant guidance. These capabilities are built around trusted organizational content and local context, keeping a human in the loop.

“Healthcare is ultimately delivered by people, so technology should be built around them,” said Arup Roy-Burman, MD, founder of Elemeno Health. “When frontline staff get the information and skills support they need in the moment, they can work with greater confidence and competence. That, in turn, supports better care, stronger job satisfaction, and a more sustainable healthcare workforce.”
