In 2026, the wood segment is expected to hold a significant global furniture market share of 62.07%, according to Fortune Business Insights. The global wooden furniture market is expected to grow from USD 461.84 billion in 2024 to USD 719.61 billion by 2032, per Data Bridge Market Research.

Consumers seeking certified sustainable furniture should verify material sourcing, finish compositions, and any applicable third-party certifications before purchase.
