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Factors Driving Growth in the In Vitro Diagnostic Packaging Market

One of the primary drivers behind the growth of the IVD packaging market is the increasing prevalence of chronic diseases and infections worldwide. Chronic illnesses and infectious diseases tend to persist over long periods, often resulting in significant health complications. The rise in incidence is largely linked to greater exposure to pathogens and lifestyle-related factors such as unhealthy diets and insufficient physical activity. IVD packaging supports the management of these conditions by enabling secure and efficient delivery of diagnostic tests, which facilitate early detection and prompt treatment—leading to improved patient outcomes and healthcare efficiencies.

Real-world evidence highlights this trend. For example, in March 2025, the UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) reported a sharp increase in measles cases in England. In 2023, there were 368 cases, nearly seven times the 53 cases recorded in 2022. The West Midlands and London accounted for 44% and 33% of these cases, respectively. This surge underscores the growing need for reliable diagnostic testing and, by extension, the demand for effective packaging solutions that maintain test integrity.
