"For 2027, we wanted to create journeys where guests can walk through the wilderness, spend meaningful time with local communities and experience the Great Migration from an entirely different perspective."



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Walking With the Great Wildebeest Migration

One of the highlights of the 2027 collection is the expansion of walking safari experiences in the Serengeti.

Rather than experiencing the Great Migration exclusively from a 4x4, travelers can ditch the vehicle for part of their journey and explore the [Serengeti on foot](#), accompanied by experienced professional guides.

Walking brings travelers closer to the details of the ecosystem—from animal tracks and birdlife to plants and the subtle signs guides use to interpret the wilderness. During migration-focused journeys, guests can experience the landscape surrounding the movement of enormous wildebeest and zebra herds from a completely different perspective.

The company's Northern Circuit Walking Safari showcases this approach, combining traditional wildlife viewing with guided exploration on foot and time in quieter wilderness areas.

Culture as Part of the Journey

The new collection also places a greater emphasis on cultural tourism—not as a quick stop between national parks, but as an important part of the overall Tanzania experience.

Selected journeys provide opportunities to spend extended time with Maasai communities, including overnight cultural experiences that allow travelers to learn about pastoral traditions, family life and the deep relationship between local communities, livestock and the land.

Guests can also spend time with the Hadzabe, one of Africa's remaining hunter-gatherer communities, and the neighboring Datoga, known for their pastoral traditions and metalworking skills.

These experiences are incorporated into carefully designed luxury journeys, allowing guests to engage more deeply with Tanzania while still enjoying exceptional accommodations, private guiding and personalized service.

Luxury Without Losing the Adventure

The philosophy behind the 2027 collection is that luxury should enhance adventure rather than separate travelers from it.

Guests might spend the morning walking through the wilderness before returning to a secluded camp for an exceptional meal and sundowner. Another day could involve time with a Maasai community followed by an evening at a luxury lodge overlooking the savannah.

Private guides, remote camps, bush meals, flexible schedules and carefully selected accommodations allow travelers to experience Tanzania with both adventure and comfort.

Luxury, in this sense, is not measured only by thread counts and infinity pools. It is also measured by privacy, access, time and the freedom to experience extraordinary places away from the crowds.

A More Complete Tanzania Experience

The new itineraries allow travelers to combine the Great Wildebeest Migration, walking safaris, traditional game drives, Maasai cultural immersion, encounters with Hadzabe and Datoga communities and remote luxury camps within a single journey.

For travelers looking to extend their adventure, itineraries can also conclude on the beaches of Zanzibar.

"Some of the moments people remember most aren't necessarily the ones they expected," Kilewo adds. "It might be walking across the Serengeti with wildebeest in the distance, sitting around a fire with Maasai hosts or simply being somewhere in the wilderness where there are no other vehicles around. Those are the experiences we want our guests to take home."
