Testing included REACH screening, ASTM coating and corrosion testing, California Proposition 65 compliance, and verification of non-detectable heavy metals. While most metal raised beds sold in the U.S. provide little or no publicly available information about the coatings that come into contact with growing soil, every Epic Gardening raised bed features a food-safe, garden-safe coating backed by independent testing.

Built to Last and Backed by Real Support

Designed for easy assembly and long-term durability, the beds are built to help gardeners of all levels grow with confidence season after season. Every raised bed includes a limited lifetime warranty against manufacturing defects for the original owner, along with a 120-day garden trial that gives gardeners an entire growing season to experience the product before committing. A dedicated customer support team responds to inquiries within 48 hours.

Epic Gardening is selling the beds at one price year-round, with no seasonal markdowns and no inflated list price to discount against. It's a pricing philosophy rooted in the company's mission to earn gardeners' trust through honest advice and transparent business practices.

Available in Mist Green, Light Clay, and Slate Grey, the collection includes Small (up to 12 sq. ft.), Medium (up to 20 sq. ft.), and Large (up to 36 sq. ft.) sizes in either a 15-inch or 29-inch height. Every modular bed can be reconfigured into multiple layouts. Prices range from \$129 to \$299. The recently launched Epic Garden Watering System, a modular drip-irrigation kit, can be added to make watering easier, and additional accessories will arrive for the spring season.
