Sanctioned party list screening protects the business. Clearing false hits drains business resources. Most SPL hits are not sanctioned entities at all. They are partial name and address matches: a common surname, a shared street, a transliterated spelling. Each one still has to be opened, judged and documented by a trained compliance professional, while the order, delivery or payment behind it sits, blocked from moving forward.

The accelerator learns from an organization's own screening history and applies that pattern recognition to hits as SAP GTS generates them. Matches that look like the false positives a team has already cleared a hundred times are flagged, with the reasoning shown. Analysts start their queue with the hits that warrant a look. It is a part of ArchLynk SPL's offering that cut false positives by 92 percent in eight weeks at a global agribusiness cooperative, taking that compliance team from thousands of hits per screening cycle to tens.

The compliance team stays in charge

The accelerator clears nothing on its own. It ranks, explains and prioritizes. Every match keeps its audit trail, every decision stays with a named reviewer, and existing SPL configuration and control settings are untouched. It runs inside the customer's own environment, against business partner and document screening in SAP GTS E4H and against non-SAP screening tools for

organizations mid-migration or running mixed estates. Screening data does not leave the customer perimeter.
