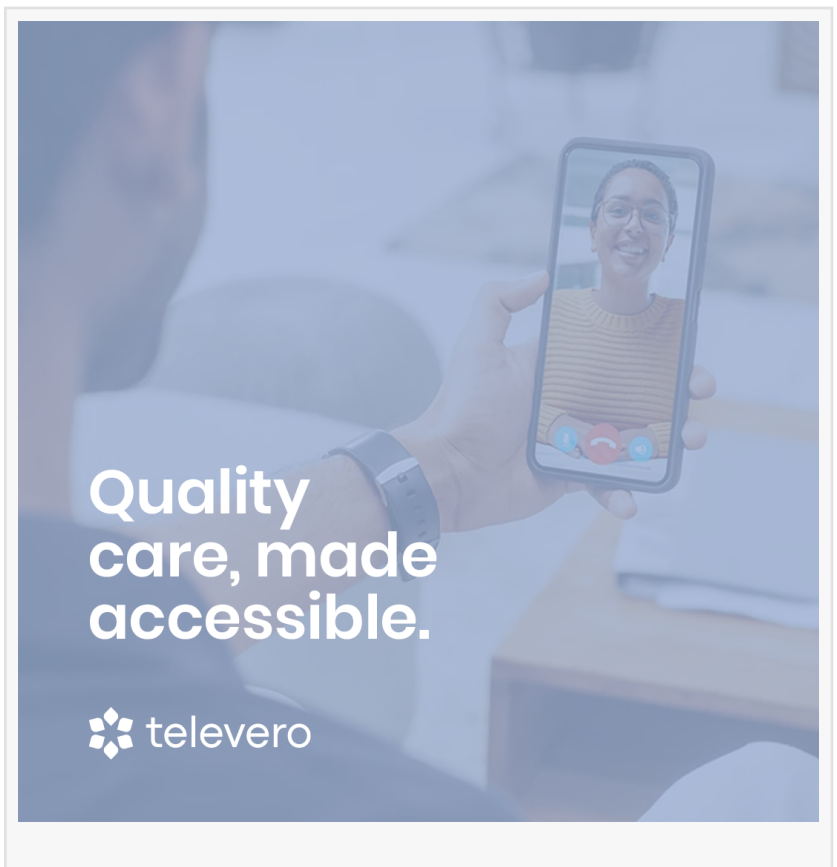

Behind the ranking are real outcomes. Televero reports 97% patient satisfaction* and 85% of patients show measurable improvement by their first follow-up**. [Clinician turnover](#) at Televero sits below 2%, compared to a behavioral health industry average of 40%. The practice has expanded to 43 states without sacrificing the clinical structure that makes those numbers

Inc. 5000 List Methodology

Companies on the 2026 Inc. 5000 are ranked according to percentage revenue growth from 2022 to 2025. To qualify, companies must have been founded and generating revenue by March 31, 2022. They must be U.S.-based, privately held, for-profit, and independent—not subsidiaries or divisions of other companies—as of December 31, 2025. (Since then, some on the list may have gone public or been acquired.) The minimum revenue required for 2022 is \$100,000; the minimum for 2025 is \$2 million. As always, Inc. reserves the right to decline applicants for

subjective reasons.
