or a burst pipe in the middle of August."

Slow-draining outdoor spigots or [hose bibs](#) are often an early sign of sediment buildup or a developing line blockage. Left untreated, these can restrict water flow to irrigation systems and outdoor fixtures throughout the season.

A sudden unexplained increase in the water bill is one of the most common indicators of a hidden leak somewhere in the system. Even a slow drip behind a wall or under a slab can waste thousands of gallons and cause significant structural damage over time.

An air conditioning unit that isn't draining properly can lead to water damage around the unit or nearby flooring. Condensate line clogs are common in summer and easy to miss until water starts backing up into the home.

Gurgling sounds from drains or toilets can indicate a partial blockage forming in the main sewer line. This is especially common after periods of heavy summer rain when ground movement can shift pipes or allow debris to enter the system.

Low water pressure throughout the home, particularly if it develops suddenly, can signal a failing pressure regulator, a developing leak, or sediment buildup in supply lines — all of which worsen over time if left unaddressed.
