One of the guide's main principles is that working with a smartphone requires the same discipline applied to a conventional camera. Composition remains essential for organizing elements within the frame, guiding the viewer's attention, and reinforcing the narrative purpose of each shot.

Stability is another central element. Although modern smartphones include advanced stabilization systems, González recommends combining technology with proper shooting techniques and using tripods or gimbals when the production requires them.

“The difference between an amateur video and a professional one is not just the camera, but the creative decisions made by the person behind it,” says Tomás Elías González Benítez.

The guide also examines the role of color in building a consistent visual identity. Controlling white balance, exposure, and color temperature helps reduce inconsistencies between shots and makes post-production more efficient.

In addition to visual fundamentals, the guide explores lighting and the way smartphone cameras respond to different conditions. Understanding shadows, contrast, and low-light environments allows creators to anticipate problems and make better decisions while filming.

Another section focuses on audio, an element that can significantly influence the perceived quality of audiovisual content. External microphones and careful selection of the recording environment can improve the final result without requiring complex equipment.

González also encourages creators to become familiar with manual controls when available. Adjusting focus, exposure, frame rate, and other settings gives videographers greater control over the image and helps them adapt to changing production conditions.

For González, the goal is not to make smartphones imitate traditional cameras, but to understand the advantages of mobile filmmaking. Portability, speed, and flexibility can create new possibilities when combined with strong audiovisual principles.

With this guide, Tomás Elías González Benítez brings together the techniques he considers essential for approaching mobile production with greater technical and narrative awareness. His proposal reflects a broader shift in the audiovisual industry: smartphones are increasingly becoming professional tools whose potential depends on the knowledge, technique, and creativity of the person using them.
