

AquaCurve Shares Side-Table Placement Tips for Shallow-Water Pool Lounger Setups

The guidance explains how a small in-pool side table can support drinks, books, sunscreen and better spacing in shallow-water lounge layouts.

The guidance focuses on a common detail in backyard pool planning: where [small poolside items](#) should go once loungers are placed in the water. Drinks, sunglasses, sunscreen, books, towels and phones often need a nearby surface, but placing those items on the pool edge can create clutter or require repeated movement in and out of the water. AquaCurve's latest guidance explains how a small table surface can support a more functional [shallow-water lounge setup](#) without taking attention away from the primary pool lounge layout.

AquaCurve's independent site is intentionally focused on five primary in-pool lounge chair styles and one supporting in-pool side table. The current lounge lineup includes Pool

Loungers in Water for Compact Tanning Ledges, In-Pool Chaise Lounge Chair for Spacious Tanning Ledges, Sun Shelf Chairs for In-Pool Use, In-Pool Lounge Chair with Armrests & Cup Holder, and Pre-Assembled Folding Pool Lounge Chair. The In-Pool Side Table is designed as a companion product for drinks, books, sunglasses, sunscreen and other small poolside items.

For compact sun shelves measuring about 50 to 62 inches deep, AquaCurve continues to point homeowners toward two shorter 43.7-inch lounge options: Pool Loungers in Water for Compact Tanning Ledges and In-Pool Lounge Chair with Armrests & Cup Holder. In these smaller layouts,

the side table should be planned carefully so the shelf does not feel crowded. A table placed to one side of a compact chair can help preserve walking space while still keeping small items within reach.

For deeper or more spacious sun shelves, all five AquaCurve pool loungers may be considered based on posture, storage needs and layout goals. Larger ledges may support paired loungers with a side table between them, a single chaise-style setup with a table at one side, or a folding lounge chair arrangement for seasonal use. In these layouts, table placement can help define the difference between a reading area, a conversation space or a more symmetrical resort-style pool scene.

AquaCurve notes that side-table placement should be considered before the second lounger is added. A shelf may physically fit two chairs, but a complete setup may also need room for pool steps, arm movement, safe entry, water circulation and access to personal items. A table placed too close to an entry point may interrupt movement, while a table placed too far from the chairs may be less useful during everyday pool use.

The guidance also applies to vacation rentals, boutique hotels and private villas where guests may use the pool area without knowing the layout in advance. Clear chair spacing, visible entry paths and accessible small-item surfaces can make a shallow ledge easier to understand and use. A compact lounger may support tighter spaces, an armrest model may support seated conversation, and a longer chaise-style lounger may support full-body relaxation on deeper shelves.

All AquaCurve in-pool loungers include weighted sandbag components intended to help reduce floating and unwanted movement on shallow ledges. Most AquaCurve loungers include one sandbag, while the Pre-Assembled Folding Pool Lounge Chair includes two sandbags. AquaCurve recommends placing loungers on flat shallow-water surfaces and following setup instructions for sandbags, headrests and assembly where applicable.

AquaCurve's in-pool lounge chair series is designed for shallow-water use, with recommended placement in water depths up to 9 inches. Products use HDPS, or high-density polystyrene, selected for outdoor and wet poolside environments. Routine care includes rinsing with fresh water and cleaning with mild soap when needed, especially after extended exposure to sunlight, chlorine, saltwater or pool chemicals.

"A side table may seem like a small detail, but it can change how a shallow-water lounge setup functions," said Qifan Zhang, AquaCurve e-commerce site supervisor. "Good placement helps keep essentials close while preserving the open space that makes a sun shelf comfortable for reading, conversation and relaxed pool use."
