launched a new patient-focused website designed to help people across Greater Philadelphia recognize common signs of vein disease, understand how specialists evaluate leg symptoms and explore treatment options before scheduling care.

The new website brings symptom education, an online vein quiz, insurance information, treatment explanations and a simple way to submit a consultation request together in one place. It also helps patients understand when leg swelling, heaviness, aching, cramping, itching,

burning, visible veins, skin discoloration or slow-healing wounds may be associated with an underlying vein condition and warrant a professional evaluation.

"Many people live with uncomfortable leg symptoms for a long time because they are not sure what is causing them or where to begin," said Bruce D. Klugherz, MD, a board-certified interventional cardiologist with AMS Vascular. "We wanted the new website to give patients clear, useful information and a straightforward path to having their concerns properly evaluated."

The website explains chronic venous insufficiency, a condition that can develop when valves in the leg veins do not work effectively. This can allow blood to pool in the legs and contribute to swelling, heaviness, aching, skin changes and other symptoms. Because these symptoms can have more than one cause, the site emphasizes the importance of an individualized clinical evaluation.

Patients can also review the practice's evaluation process before their first visit. The process begins with a consultation focused on symptoms, medical history and treatment goals. A same-day ultrasound may then help the clinical team identify the source of the symptoms and develop a treatment plan based on the patient's diagnosis and needs.

Clear Information About Modern Vein Treatment

The website provides plain-language information about [minimally invasive vein treatments](#) available through AMS Vascular, including radiofrequency ablation, Varithena treatment and microphlebectomy. Radiofrequency ablation uses controlled heat to close a diseased vein. Varithena uses polidocanol injectable foam to treat certain affected veins. Microphlebectomy removes bulging surface varicose veins through very small incisions under local anesthesia. The most appropriate option depends on the patient's ultrasound findings, medical history and individual treatment goals.

AMS Vascular's clinical team includes Noah Rosen, MD, MBA, a board-certified vascular surgeon with more than 20 years of experience treating venous and arterial disease, and Dr. Klugherz, who specializes in coronary, peripheral arterial and venous disease, and structural heart procedures.
