The move responds directly to Senate Republicans' blockade of legislation that would have expanded military health coverage of in vitro fertilization to all service members and their families.

The free baseline evaluation includes ovarian reserve testing, semen analysis, assessment of tubes and uterus, and a consultation with a Pozitivf fertility practitioner—removing the financial and logistical barriers many military families face when seeking answers.

"Congress just decided that military families don't deserve the same access to fertility care as civilians," said Dr. Arredondo, Founder, CEO, and Chief Medical Officer of Pozitivf Fertility. "We're here to fill that gap. If the government won't expand access, we will."

The Senate Armed Services Committee voted unanimously against Senator Tammy Duckworth's proposal to extend military IVF coverage beyond service-connected infertility in a closed-door meeting this summer. The measure had passed with voice vote approval the prior year, marking a stark reversal driven by pressure from anti-abortion advocacy groups opposed to IVF.

Pozitivf's new military program removes upfront financial barriers and offers ongoing savings. For active duty, reserve, and veteran patients in Houston and San Antonio, the free baseline evaluation provides clarity on their fertility options without out-of-pocket cost, and the 10 percent discount applies to all subsequent care.

"Our patients come to us because we're transparent, efficient, and affordable," said Dr. Jaye

Adams, Pozitivf's senior reproductive endocrinologist. "Adding this program is personal for me. I spent 22 years serving in the U.S. Air Force and retired as a Lt. Colonel in 2018. I know what military families sacrifice. Service shouldn't mean sacrificing your chance to have a family of your own."

Dr. Adams joined Pozitivf's care team to help expand access to the fertility care that military personnel have historically struggled to obtain.
