Companies are ranked by percentage revenue growth over a three-year period. This year's honorees include a wide range of consumer, technology, and manufacturing companies competing for a place among the nation's most dynamic private businesses.

Douglass and Jason Barrow, brothers and owners, said "this recognition belongs to our entire team, everyone roasting, packing, shipping, and selling across all five of our brands every day. Being named to the Inc. 5000 validates the strategy we've been building for years, and we're proud to represent Colorado on a national stage. We're just getting started."

Luna's growth has been fueled by expansion across its five-brand coffee and tea portfolio, Boyer's Coffee, Boulder Organic Coffee, Luna Roasters, Boca Java, and CoffeeAM alongside new and expanding retail partnerships with major national grocery and club retailers. The company operates a 40,000-square-foot specialty coffee roastery in Colorado, where it roasts specialty-

grade coffee and blends whole-leaf tea for customers nationwide.

This is not the first time Luna has earned national recognition for its growth, the company previously debuted on the Inc. 5000 in 2018. Companies on the Inc. 5000 list are ranked according to their percentage of revenue growth over three years from 2022 to 2025.
