For traditional hot beverages, a single inner layer is often entirely sufficient to block liquid penetration and maintain structural integrity under extreme thermal stress. Conversely, cold juices and heavily iced drinks that are highly prone to generating aggressive exterior condensation may mandate double-sided PE protection. This dual-layer approach effectively

prevents the outer paper surface from absorbing atmospheric moisture and catastrophically weakening over time. Professional buyers must specify their exact hot and cold use parameters, including expected hold times, transport conditions, and peak serving temperatures, to ensure the exact right coating application is deployed for their specific operational context.

Water Based Flexographic Printing for Custom Branding
