Aluminum's combination of structural strength, corrosion resistance, slim profile options, and compatibility with high-performance glazing systems makes it the dominant frame material in

commercial and mid-to-high-end residential fenestration globally. DERCHI's window range is organized into three principal categories, each covering multiple configurations.

Casement Windows — The casement series includes the K5N Inward Casement, N9 Large Size Tilt-and-Turn, and S63 Top Hung Awning Casement. Tilt-and-turn units in particular are widely specified across European and international residential projects for their dual-mode operation: top-tilt for passive ventilation and full side-swing for access and cleaning. All casement units are available in custom dimensions and frame depths.

Sliding Windows — The 105B, E3T, and G46 Sliding Tilt-Turn models serve projects where outward clearance is constrained — dense urban residential buildings, villa compounds, and hospitality developments. The G46's sliding-plus-tilt mechanism provides ventilation flexibility while maintaining the clean sightlines that contemporary architectural specifications increasingly demand.

Picture Windows — Fixed-pane configurations are specified where daylighting and unobstructed views take priority over operability: high-end villas, hotel lobbies, commercial interiors. DERCHI's picture windows are fully customizable in glass type, frame profile, and dimension.

Every unit across these series undergoes 168 production processes and 38 inspection checkpoints before dispatch, with a ten-year warranty and double insurance coverage backing each product.

One-Stop Custom Solutions Across Global Markets

The distinction between a manufacturer that exports and one that delivers custom aluminium window solutions for specific regional contexts becomes clear when comparing what different markets actually require.

North America — Hurricane Compliance and Whole-House Fenestration

Among the regional compliance frameworks DERCHI's products are engineered to address, U.S. hurricane-zone requirements remain one of the most technically demanding. For projects in Florida, the Texas Gulf Coast, and other high-risk coastal areas, hurricane-impact windows must satisfy a layered certification structure before they can legally be installed.

The most stringent benchmark is the Miami-Dade Notice of Acceptance (NOA) — mandatory for Florida's High-Velocity Hurricane Zones (HVHZ) and widely referenced as the de facto standard across U.S. coastal procurement. Products must pass TAS 201/203 testing, including large and small missile impact simulation and cyclic wind pressure cycling, as well as ASTM E1886/E1996 for windborne debris impact resistance. The AAMA/WDMA/CSA 101/I.S.2/A440 standard further governs baseline structural performance, air infiltration, and water resistance across North American specifications.

In practical terms, a compliant window must resist penetration from windborne debris, withstand repeated pressure fluctuations throughout a sustained storm event, and prevent water infiltration under driven rain — all without frame deformation or glazing failure. DERCHI's Glass Self-Adaptive Adjustment System patent is specifically engineered to distribute stress across the glazing assembly under these load conditions, directly addressing the failure modes these tests expose. The Exclusive Four-Side Six-Point Lock patent (No. ZL201610053534.X) reinforces frame integrity at the highest mechanical stress points during wind-load events.

At the same time, the North American villa and luxury residential segment typically requires a coordinated fenestration package across windows, entry doors, bifold and sliding terrace doors, and glazed enclosures — all matched in finish, hardware, and specification. DERCHI's integrated product range covers all of these categories from a single manufacturing facility, eliminating the lead time mismatches and specification inconsistencies that often arise when components are sourced separately.

Documented U.S. project cases include full-house deployments across Los Angeles villa projects, a whole-house custom project in Atlanta, Georgia, and multiple residential installations in Southern California.

Middle East — Thermal Performance and Large-Scale Projects

Gulf region projects — across the UAE, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, and neighboring markets — typically involve high solar gain environments where thermal control is the primary glazing specification driver. Frame thermal break design, low-E glass selection, and solar heat gain coefficient (SHGC) values all require market-specific configuration. DERCHI has established distribution presence in the UAE and Qatar and has delivered across the wider Gulf region, with product configurations adapted to regional thermal and dust-exposure conditions. The ENERGY STAR certification in DERCHI's portfolio reflects a product engineering standard that aligns with the energy performance expectations increasingly embedded in Middle Eastern commercial development codes.

Europe — Regulatory Conformity and Tilt-Turn Preference

European procurement centers on CE Marking compliance — the conformity framework governing product performance documentation across EU construction standards. DERCHI holds CE certification, providing the documentation foundation that European buyers require for both specification and project approval workflows. Technically, the European market also shows strong preference for tilt-and-turn casement mechanisms and thermally broken frame systems — both core to DERCHI's casement product architecture.

Australia and Oceania — AGWA Certification and Villa Projects

DERCHI holds AGWA (Australian Glass and Window Association) certification, the relevant performance standard for the Australian market. Distribution infrastructure in Australia supports project delivery for the residential and villa development segment, where complete façade

fenestration packages — matched windows, sliding doors, and entry systems — are typically required as a coordinated supply.

Manufacturing Scale and Quality Infrastructure

For international buyers managing multi-unit or repeat procurement, consistency across production batches matters as much as first-order quality. DERCHI's 360-degree intelligent manufacturing quality control system monitors output continuously, maintaining dimensional and performance tolerances across high-volume runs.
