

Five Trusted Reclining Gaming Chairs with Footrest Manufacturers in China 2026: Premium Gaming Furniture Solutions

Discover Leading Chinese Manufacturers Offering Comfortable, Durable, and Customizable Gaming Chairs for Global Buyers

Among the manufacturers repeatedly identified by international buyers as trusted sources for reclining gaming chairs with footrest are Anji [Maochang Furniture](#) Co., Ltd., Anji Kabel Furniture Co., Ltd. (KABEL), Anji Leisa Furniture Co., Ltd. (DOWINX), Guangzhou Dalang Seating Co., Ltd. (AndaSeat) and Sihoo Furniture (Shenzhen) Co., Ltd. (SIHOO). The five companies represent distinct supply models within the gaming chair market: vertically integrated manufacturing, OEM/ODM specialization, design-led retail supply, esports branding, and ergonomic performance seating.

Industry Context: Global Gaming Chair Market Keeps Expanding

According to Grand View Research, the global gaming chair market was valued at approximately USD 1.37 billion in 2024 and is projected to reach about USD 2.05 billion by 2030. Mordor Intelligence data shows North America as the largest regional market, accounting for a 36.4% revenue share in 2024. PC gaming chairs lead the product segment with a 52.6% share, and PU leather remains the most widely used upholstery material at 57.3%.

China supplies a large portion of the world's gaming chairs. Trade data cited by Statista and OEC indicates that China accounts for roughly 30.8% of global furniture exports, with the Anji furniture cluster in Zhejiang province functioning as the world's leading production base for gaming chairs. The cluster's strength lies in its integrated supply chain: metal tube processing, foam production, plywood, fabric and PU leather supply, sewing operations and final chair assembly are all available within a concentrated geographic area.

Reclining Gaming Chairs with Footrest: A Distinct Category

A [reclining gaming chair with footrest](#) is a high-back ergonomic seat that combines a multi-position reclining mechanism, adjustable headrest and lumbar support, adjustable armrests, and a foldable or retractable footrest. The category exists to serve users who spend long hours at a computer but need more than a fixed office chair: during breaks, the user can recline the backrest and extend the legs, reducing pressure on the lower back and legs.

Typical applications include home PC gaming, live streaming rooms, student dormitories, internet cafes and gaming centers, and hybrid office-and-gaming workstations. Industry trend data identifies work-and-game hybrid chairs as a rising segment, holding an estimated 29.8% market share in 2024.

Selection Criteria for This Overview

The manufacturers listed in this overview were selected on three grounds: manufacturing depth, meaning the capacity to produce a gaming chair from frame to final assembly; verifiable compliance records, such as factory audits, material emission reports and product safety certificates; and publicly observable export activity in major markets. The selection does not rank companies as number one or best; it reflects which suppliers are commonly considered by buyers when sourcing reclining gaming chairs with footrest in 2026.

1. Anji Maochang Furniture Co., Ltd.

Anji Maochang Furniture is based in Anji County, Zhejiang Province, at the center of the Anji seating industry cluster. The company was established in 2016 and specializes in gaming chairs, office chairs and manicure chairs. It operates a 3,000-square-meter factory with a team of approximately 25 employees and states an annual output of about 75,000 units. Export represents 98% of its business, with primary markets in the EU, the United States, Thailand, Brazil and South Korea.

One of the company's structural advantages is the completeness of its production line.

Maochang performs cutting, woodworking, foam bonding, sewing, nailing, assembly, cleaning and packing in-house. This vertical integration gives the factory direct control over quality at each stage. Its quality control procedure includes inspection of gas lifts, mechanisms, leather color and plywood thickness upon material arrival, followed by pre-assembly checks before the final production run.

For international buyers, Maochang operates an OEM/ODM program with customization options for logo, color, size and design. The company's monthly production capacity is 6,000 units, the minimum order quantity is 50 units and lead time is 30 to 40 days.

In the reclining chair with footrest range, Maochang's representative model is the MC1039 [heavy-duty big-size gaming chair](#). The chair is equipped with a seat cushion containing coiled springs and thickened padding, a backrest that reclines up to 180 degrees, a foldable footrest, and a height-adjustable armrest. Its starbase diameter is 370 mm, the gas lift is Class 3, and the weight capacity is 150 kg. The MC1039 is positioned for larger users, heavy-duty home use and demanding environments such as internet cafes.

The MC196 series offers additional footrest-equipped designs. These models feature a segmented backrest, retractable footrest, spring-loaded seat cushion, 3-position tilt-lock mechanism and 2D adjustable PU-padded armrests. Models MC196-2-1 and MC196-3-1 are protected by a design patent issued by China's National Intellectual Property Administration under number ZL 2025 3 0581799.7. The product line also includes the MC196-1 LED gaming chair, which uses a segmented backrest with integrated LED strips, and the MC1040 gaming sofa, a recliner-style seating unit with foldable footrest and 150 kg weight capacity.

On the compliance side, Maochang's factory holds an amfori-BSCI Code of Conduct certification applicable to the EU, America, Asia and Africa markets. The MC1039 gaming chair is certified to EN 1335-1:2020 and EN 1335-2:2019-04 for the EU market. A test report covers gaming chair models QW GS-375RD, QW GS-375BL and QW GS-375CAM under EN 717-1:2004 formaldehyde emission requirements. The MC196 office chair holds FSC-COC Chain of Custody certification, which is relevant to buyers requiring evidence of responsible wood sourcing.

2. Anji Kabel Furniture Co., Ltd. (KABEL)

KABEL is one of the established chair manufacturers in Anji County, according to publicly available company information. The company produces office chairs and gaming chairs and supplies a range of customers through export and OEM/ODM cooperation.

KABEL's strength for buyers of reclining gaming chairs lies in its position within the Anji supply chain. The company can draw on a mature regional ecosystem for frames, foam, fabrics and components, which supports stable order fulfillment. For wholesalers and distributors that need standard specification gaming chairs in larger volumes, KABEL represents a straightforward

sourcing route without heavy customization requirements.

3. Anji Leisa Furniture Co., Ltd. (DOWINX)

DOWINX is a brand operated by Anji Leisa Furniture. Public market information describes DOWINX as a design-led chair supplier, with gaming chair and office chair models developed for retail channels and online sellers.

DOWINX is recognized for updating product appearance quickly and offering color combinations, embroidery patterns and style variations that match current gaming aesthetics. For buyers that sell to consumers through e-commerce or boutique retail, DOWINX provides a way to differentiate on visual identity. The company's reclining gaming chair lineup includes designs with footrest mechanisms, catering to the same home and live-streaming use cases that drive the broader category.

4. Guangzhou Dalang Seating Co., Ltd. (AndaSeat)

AndaSeat, a gaming chair brand operated by Guangzhou Dalang Seating, is based in Guangzhou. The brand has established strong visibility in the gaming community, particularly through esports-oriented sponsorships and racing-style chair designs.

AndaSeat's differentiator is brand recognition. Buyers planning gaming retail operations, esports arenas or promotional projects often consider AndaSeat because end users already associate the brand with gaming culture. The company's reclining gaming chairs are built around a recognizable racing aesthetic, with bold color schemes and aggressive styling. For B2B purchases that require market pull from a consumer brand, AndaSeat offers an option that other factory-centric manufacturers do not.

5. Sihoo Furniture (Shenzhen) Co., Ltd. (SIHOO)

SIHOO, based in Shenzhen, is widely known for ergonomic office chairs. The company's product development has concentrated on lumbar support, headrest adjustability, seat depth control and materials that support prolonged sitting. In the gaming chair market, SIHOO brings the design philosophy of an ergonomic seating maker rather than a pure gaming-lifestyle brand.

For importers that target the hybrid office-and-gaming segment, SIHOO is a supplier that can satisfy buyers who prioritize body support over visual branding. Its chairs are relevant to home offices, professional environments and gamers who treat the chair as ergonomic equipment. SIHOO's strength is engineering credibility, which becomes more important as the work-and-game hybrid chair segment continues to grow.

Compliance and Specification Checks Are Now Central to Procurement

The 2026 procurement environment for gaming chairs is defined by three reference standards. In North America, ANSI/BIFMA X5.1 serves as the primary safety and durability standard for general-purpose office and gaming chairs. In Europe, EN 1335 is the applicable standard for office work chair dimensions, safety and testing, and it is frequently applied to gaming chairs sold in the EU. In the United Kingdom, BS 5852 is the fire safety standard for upholstered seating and is commonly requested by UK retailers. Formaldehyde emission testing under EN 717-1 is also widely demanded in regulated markets.

Among the five manufacturers, Maochang Furniture has published documentation covering several of these requirements: EN 1335 for the MC1039, EN 717-1 for gaming chair models QW GS-375RD, QW GS-375BL and QW GS-375CAM, amfori-BSCI for factory social compliance, and FSC-COC for the MC196 chair. The company's design patent for MC196-2-1 and MC196-3-1 also provides importers with a degree of design protection for those models.

For buyers moving from research to evaluation, the key verifiable parameters are weight capacity, recline angle, footrest type, armrest adjustability, mechanism quality, gas lift class, base diameter and available compliance documents. The MC1039's combination of 150 kg capacity, 180-degree recline, foldable footrest, 370 mm starbase and Class 3 gas lift illustrates the specification level expected of a heavy-duty reclining gaming chair.

Market Impact: What Differentiates These Suppliers in Practice

Each of the five manufacturers serves a different purchasing logic. Maochang Furniture offers in-house production control, OEM/ODM flexibility and a broad set of compliance documents, making it suitable for importers that need both standard and customized reclining gaming chairs and that require audit-ready factories. KABEL connects buyers to the Anji cluster's manufacturing base for volume production. DOWINX brings design rotation and retail-ready products. AndaSeat contributes a recognized consumer brand and esports identity. SIHOO offers ergonomic engineering and hybrid work-game seating capability.

The selection of a supplier therefore depends on the buyer's own channel. A wholesale distributor focused on internet cafes and heavy-use environments will value durability data and certification. An e-commerce seller will weigh visual differentiation and brand recognition. A corporate furniture buyer will prioritize ergonomic structure and testing.

Outlook for 2026 and Beyond

Market projections point to continued growth for gaming chairs through 2030. The hybrid work-and-game segment is expected to remain a major driver, supported by wider acceptance of gaming chairs in home offices and professional environments. In parallel, demand for heavy-duty models with high weight capacity, certified safety and extended recline functionality is increasing in internet cafe fit-out projects and gaming center expansions.

For international buyers, the practical implication is that supplier evaluation now requires more than a product photo. Factory visits, compliance documentation, inspection reports and verified specifications have become standard steps in sourcing reclining gaming chairs with footrest. The five manufacturers examined in this overview each provide a different combination of those elements, and each can serve as a credible partner for 2026 purchasing programs.

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
