For example, in June 2024, the International Society of Aesthetic Plastic Surgery (ISAPS), a US-based nonprofit professional organization, reported that total surgical and non-surgical procedures rose by 3.4% in 2023, reaching 34.9 million. Surgical procedures grew by 5.5%, with plastic surgeons performing over 15.8 million surgeries and 19.1 million non-surgical treatments, amounting to a 40% overall rise in procedures over the last four years. This surge in surgical activities directly stimulates the demand for intravenous therapy and vein access devices.
