One of the strongest factors driving growth in this market is the increasing prevalence of diabetes worldwide. For example, according to a February 2025 report by The Guardian, a UK news outlet, about 12.2 million people in the United Kingdom were affected by diabetes or non-diabetic hyperglycaemia. This group includes 4.6 million diagnosed diabetes patients, 1.3 million undiagnosed cases, and 6.3 million individuals with non-diabetic hyperglycaemia, marking an increase from an estimated 12.1 million cases between 2023 and 2024. Such figures underline how the rising diabetes prevalence is a key driver of the lancing devices and equipment market.
