

Fort Collins and Loveland See Rising Demand for Local Movers as Region Grows

Skyline Moving Company reports increased local move volume as more residents relocate to and within Northern Colorado's Fort Collins-Loveland area.

Loveland's population has grown by more than 8% since the 2020 census, and the broader [Fort Collins](#) -Loveland region continues to draw families, students, and professionals relocating from Denver and beyond.

"We're hearing it from customers every week: people are choosing Northern Colorado because it offers a smaller-town feel without giving up access to jobs, good schools, and the outdoors," said Stephen and Justin, co-owners of Skyline Moving Company. "As more people move here, or move between our local cities as their needs change, we've adjusted our crews and scheduling to keep up."

A Region on the Move

Loveland's growth rate has outpaced many of its neighbors in recent years, and Fort Collins continues to be one of the largest cities in the state. Together, the two cities anchor a metro area that has become one of the more sought-after places to live along the Front Range. Skyline Moving has responded by expanding its service area to include [Greeley](#), Windsor, Timnath, Wellington, Longmont, and Denver, in addition to its home base in Loveland and its long-standing coverage of Fort Collins.

The company attributes the rising demand to a mix of factors:

New residents relocating from the Denver metro area seeking more affordable housing and a slower pace of life

Local moves within Fort Collins and Loveland as families upsize, downsize, or change neighborhoods

Students and staff connected to Colorado State University and the University of Northern Colorado moving seasonally

Continued new-home construction across Larimer and Weld counties

Skyline Moving has also noticed a shift in the types of moves it's booking. Where the company once handled mostly single-family relocations within the same neighborhood, crews are now just as likely to be moving renters into new apartment communities, retirees downsizing from larger homes, or families relocating from out of state who need extra guidance navigating an unfamiliar area.

"A lot of our customers moving in from Denver or out of state have never lived in Fort Collins or Loveland before," said Stephen and Justin. "They're not just hiring us to move boxes, they want to know which neighborhoods fit their budget, how far things are from work or school, and what to expect from the change in pace. We try to be a resource for that, not just the crew that shows up on moving day."

What This Means for People Moving to Northern Colorado

With demand climbing, Skyline Moving encourages anyone planning a move in the region to book several weeks in advance, particularly during the busy summer months between May and August when both local moves and long-distance relocations peak. Weekends and the end of each month tend to fill up fastest, and the company has added crew capacity this year specifically to keep wait times manageable during peak season.

The company offers residential and local moving services throughout Northern Colorado, with crews based locally in Loveland rather than dispatched from out of the area. Skyline Moving says

that local familiarity, knowing the neighborhoods, the traffic patterns, and the quirks of older homes near Old Town Fort Collins versus newer construction in Windsor or Timnath, continues to be one of the biggest differentiators customers mention when choosing a mover.

As Northern Colorado's population growth shows few signs of slowing, Skyline Moving expects the current pace of demand to continue into next year, and the company says it will keep evaluating its service area and staffing to match.
