The donation is part of a collaborative humanitarian effort alongside the National Portable Storage Association (NPSA) and the We Love Foundation Inc. (formerly I Love Venezuela Foundation). Together with industry partners, the NPSA coalition is providing 22 cargo containers to assist the Dominican Red Cross, the Government of the Dominican Republic, and shipping partner Antillean Line. Supplies will be loaded in Puerto Rico and routed through Miami to reach communities in crisis.

Practical, weatherproof storage is a crucial link in getting aid to disaster zones safely. The donated 20ft container will serve as a secure vessel, keeping medical supplies, food, clean water, and shelter materials protected from weather damage throughout transit.

Ground efforts and distribution are being guided by the We Love Foundation, an organization dedicated to delivering direct relief and long-term hope to vulnerable populations.

"Bringing hope to people who are hurting means everything," said Santi Chumaceiro, Co-Founder & President of We Love Foundation. "People joining forces for the good of humanity is a powerful thing, and this partnership reflects what can happen when we simply come together to care for one another."
