"As organizations strengthen data governance for the AI era, print security should be treated as an essential part of enterprise IP protection, not an operational afterthought."

Manufacturing organizations continue to rely on printed information throughout product development, production, quality assurance, supplier collaboration, and regulatory compliance. Engineering drawings, production schedules, inspection reports, process documentation, and technical specifications are frequently printed for day-to-day operation.

Yet, once information leaves the digital environment, traditional cybersecurity controls often lose visibility. Printed documents can be copied, misplaced, or distributed without authorization, creating opportunities for IP theft, insider misuse, and accidental disclosure. While manufacturers have strengthened protection for files and endpoints, printed documents remain one of the last unmanaged channels within manufacturing environments.

At the same time, stricter compliance requirements and heightened concerns over trade secret protection are driving manufacturers to establish stronger governance over how critical information is printed, shared, retained, and audited throughout its lifecycle.
