For many adult children, this question comes up after a fall, a health scare, or a visible change in a parent's routine. A son or daughter may already be balancing work, children, and regular check-ins with a loved one who is becoming more isolated or needs more help day to day. Clear information can make those decisions feel less overwhelming.

This distinction also matters when families are weighing support at home against assisted living.



In some situations, a loved one does not need to leave home to receive meaningful help. A steady caregiver, a safer routine, and regular companionship may be the missing piece that helps a senior continue living at home with dignity and more confidence.

### What In-Home Care Often Includes
