This method effectively eliminates microorganisms such as bacteria, viruses, and spores while providing rapid sterilization without leaving harmful residues. It is widely used to ensure the safety and functionality of sensitive medical devices that cannot be exposed to high heat or steam sterilization.

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Healthcare-Associated Infections as a Key Driver of Market Expansion

The rising incidence of healthcare-associated infections (HAIs) is a significant factor propelling growth in the low temperature plasma sterilizer market. HAIs occur when patients contract infections during treatment in healthcare facilities, often due to invasive procedures and device use that increase the risk of pathogen transmission. Low temperature plasma sterilizers contribute to reducing HAIs by efficiently sterilizing heat-sensitive medical tools without toxic residue, allowing safe reuse and improving infection control measures.

For example, in July 2025, the UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) reported an increase in methicillin-resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* (MRSA) bacteraemia cases in the UK, rising from 1.7 to 1.8 cases per 100,000 population between the first quarters of 2024 and 2025. Such trends highlight the urgent need for effective sterilization technologies, further driving demand for low temperature plasma sterilizers.
