This forecasted expansion is supported by technological improvements in both pulsatile and non-pulsatile flow devices, increased use of minimally invasive cardiac procedures, greater adoption of left and biventricular assist devices, the growth and development of hospitals and specialty cardiac centers, and heightened investment in

cardiac care research and development. Key trends shaping the market include the rising use of ventricular assist devices and total artificial hearts, growth in cardiac surgery and heart failure treatment, expanding application of extracorporeal membrane oxygenation (ECMO) systems, a focus on minimally invasive and percutaneous device deployment, and enhanced compliance with regulatory and safety standards for cardiac devices.

This figure is expected to increase substantially, reaching 8.7 million by 2030, 10.3 million by 2040, and an estimated 11.4 million by 2050. Such a significant rise in heart failure cases is a major driver for expanding the mechanical circulatory support devices market.
