Aqore ranked #1,793 overall and #147 among software companies in the 2026 list, moving up 33% from its 2025

ranking of #2,696. The company also ranked #195 in Texas and #76 in the Dallas-Fort Worth-Arlington metropolitan area.

The recognition comes as staffing and recruiting firms increasingly seek technology platforms that can streamline operations, improve visibility, and reduce the complexity created by disconnected systems.

As staffing firms grow, so does the volume and complexity of the work behind the scenes. More candidates, jobs, clients, employees, timecards, payroll transactions, compliance requirements, billing activity, and data can create increasingly fragmented workflows when teams rely on multiple systems.

Connected Staffing Technology Built for Growth

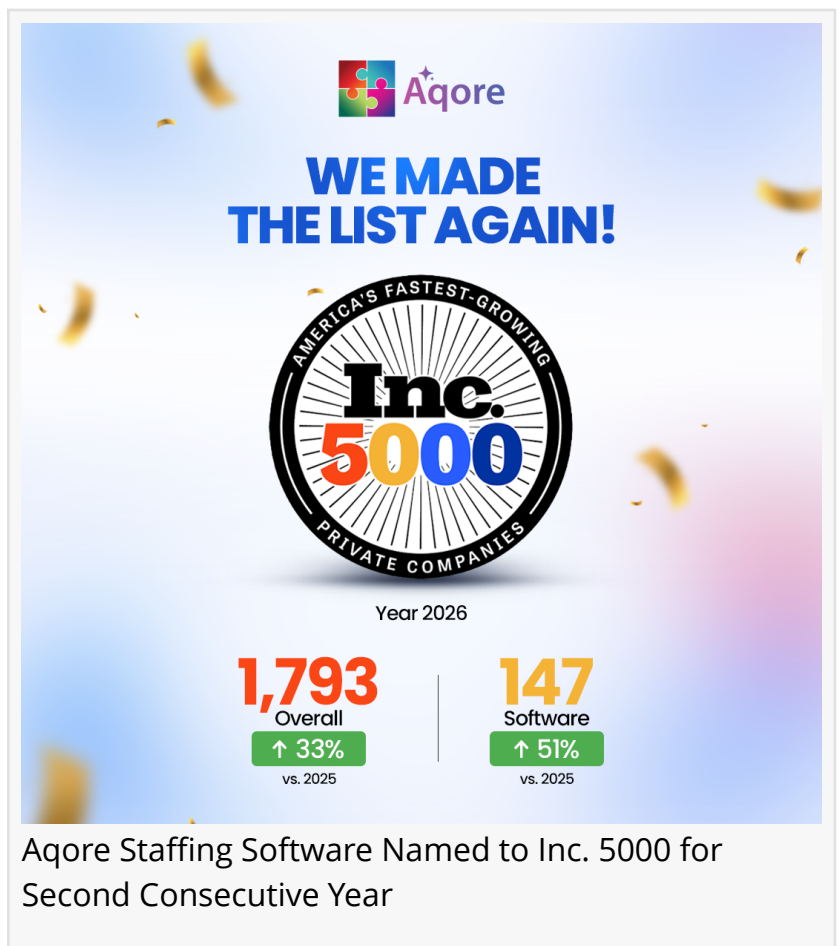
