The market size is projected to shrink from \$10.75 billion in 2025 to \$9.76 billion in 2026, representing a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of -9.3%. This decline during the historical period is mainly due to a reduction in airborne infectious diseases, limited growth in

healthcare infrastructure, slow progress in preventing hospital-acquired infections, and decreased large-scale emergency purchases of medical masks.

Looking further ahead, the market is expected to continue contracting, reaching \$6.54 billion by 2030 with a CAGR of -9.5%. This ongoing decline can be linked to diminishing emphasis on pandemic preparedness, reduced demand from occupational fields outside healthcare, slower development of sustainable personal protective equipment (PPE) production, and lower adoption rates for reusable masks. Despite this, certain trends are emerging, such as growing use of high-filtration respirators, increased preference for fluid-resistant surgical masks, greater adoption of reusable and environmentally friendly materials, expansion in automated mask manufacturing, and enhanced attention to mask comfort and breathability.

N95 respirators and surgical masks serve as personal protective equipment designed to shield the wearer from airborne particles and liquids that could contaminate the face. These masks come in various thicknesses and levels of protection against liquid exposure. Such characteristics influence not only the effectiveness of protection but also the ease of breathing while wearing the mask.

Rising Incidence of Airborne Diseases Boosts Demand for Masks

One of the main factors encouraging growth in the masks market is the increasing occurrence of airborne infections. Airborne transmission involves the spread of diseases through droplet nuclei that remain infectious when suspended in the air for extended periods and across long distances. Preventative measures focus on creating barriers and reducing or eliminating microbes in the environment or on personal items to interrupt these transmission pathways. For example, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) in the United States, tuberculosis cases rose from 8,320 in 2022 to 9,615 in 2023, an increase of 1,295 cases. Additionally, the incidence rate went up from 2.5 per 100,000 individuals in 2022 to 2.9 per 100,000 in 2023. Such statistics highlight how the rising prevalence of airborne infections continues to support demand for N95 respirators and surgical masks.
