Looking ahead, the market is projected to keep expanding and reach \$2.36 billion by 2030,



growing at a CAGR of 9.0%. Key contributors to this forecasted growth include the development of automated and electromechanical thrombectomy devices, the rising incidence of ischemic stroke and coronary thrombosis, incorporation of AI-assisted navigation in devices, the growth of ambulatory surgical centers and invasive care facilities, and escalating investments in research and development of thrombectomy technologies.
