The center also uses adaptive learning materials, visual communication systems, tactile learning aids, interactive educational tools, individualized sensory supports, and adaptive sports such as bocce. Staff members also support students who communicate through sign language, while parents and caregivers are included through regular meetings, workshops, and collaboration with teachers and therapists.

The CAC renewal reflects Saraswati Learning Center's commitment to staff development, individualized student support, accessibility, and inclusive education. By completing IBCCES training, certification, and onsite review requirements, the center supports an educational environment that adapts to student's needs..
