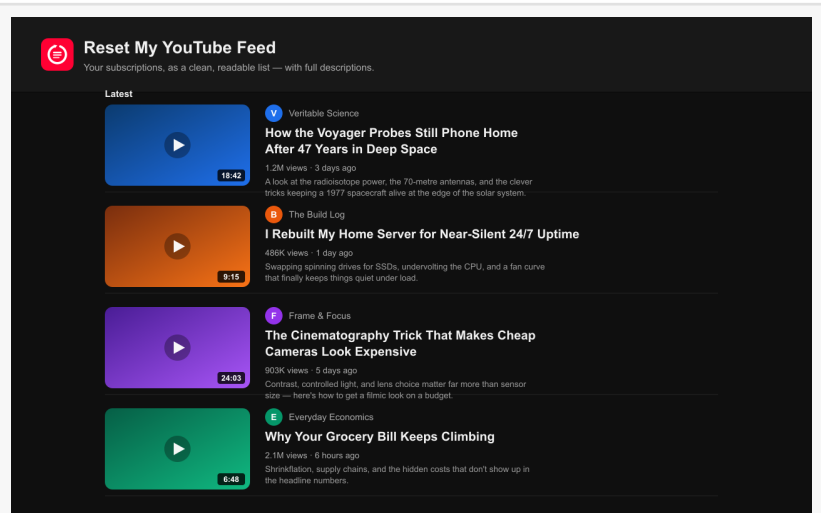


# Reset My YouTube Feed Adds a Clean YouTube List View and Hides Shorts From Subscriptions

*Free, privacy-first Chrome extension: organize YouTube subscriptions in a clean YouTube list view, hide YouTube Shorts, and filter the noise.*

Built for people who follow dozens or hundreds of channels, the extension is a simple way to [organize YouTube subscriptions](#) - replacing YouTube's grid of oversized thumbnails with readable rows that show each video's full title, channel, upload date, and description inline.



Reset My YouTube Feed turns the YouTube Subscriptions feed into a clean, single-column list view.

Most YouTube tools take one of two approaches: a pile of separate "hide Shorts" toggles, or heavy "focus mode" blockers aimed at the homepage. Reset My YouTube Feed is different. It rebuilds the Subscriptions feed itself into a [YouTube list view](#) - a reading layout for the channels you actually chose - and then hands you the controls to declutter it.

What it does (free, forever):

- YouTube list view for Subscriptions: a clean, single-column reading layout with full video descriptions loaded inline.
- Hide YouTube Shorts, live streams, and premieres from the feed with a single switch.
- Keyword and channel blacklist: mute clickbait terms,

spoilers, or entire channels without unsubscribing.

- Search, sort, and catch-up tools to instantly filter your feed and mark everything as seen.
- Calm mode: grayscale thumbnails and tidy, de-clickbaited titles for a distraction-free feed.
- Duration overlays, scheduled focus hours, light and dark themes, and one-click settings backup.

Optional Premium upgrade:

Power users can unlock a YouTube list view on channel pages (Videos and Live), smart filters by video length and upload date, filters and blacklists across all of YouTube, channel folders with per-channel rules (mute, snooze, pin), saved custom layouts, 20+ accent themes, and turbo description loading.

Private by design: the free features run entirely in your browser, require no account, and include no ads, no tracking, and no third-party analytics. Video descriptions are read directly from YouTube and cached locally on your device. Only if you buy Premium does the extension contact the company's server to validate your license key, and payments are handled securely by Stripe.

Pricing and availability: Reset My YouTube Feed is available now, free, on the Chrome Web Store for Google Chrome and Chromium-based browsers such as Microsoft Edge and Brave, with a Firefox version on the way. Premium is optional and starts at \$0.99 per month, \$9.99 per year, or \$29.99 for lifetime access.
